OFFICIAL NOTICE AND CONDITIONS OF RACE SECOND ADDENDUM

July 21, 2004

3. ALTERATIONS OF CLASS RULES:

Add Hawaii Yacht Racing Association approved modifications to the **ISAF SPECIAL REGULATIONS Governing Offshore and Oceanic Racing Extract for Race Category 3 Monohulls (2004-2005)**:

- 3.1.9 Modifies 3.27.4, HYRA prescribes that for the purposes of local racing in Hawaii, emergency navigation lights may be provided by a portable dry cell battery pack temporarily mounted on the bow pulpit.
- 3.2.0 Modifies 4.10, HYRA prescribes that for the purposes of local racing in Hawaii, radar reflectors are not required for Category 4 races.
- 3.2.1 Modifies 4.26, Storm & heavy weather sails, HYRA prescribes that for local racing in Hawaii, the requirements for storm and heavy weather sails will not apply to Category 4 races but will apply to Category 3 races. HYRA further prescribes that the minimum requirements for Storm and Heavy Weather Sails for Category 3 races are as follows: A heavy weather jib that meets the requirements of paragraph 4.26.4 and mainsail reefing to reduce the luff by at least 10%.
- 3.2.2 Modifies 5.02, HYRA prescribes that for the purposes of local racing in Hawaii, there shall be a sufficient number of safety harnesses for 2/3 of the crew.
