NOTICE OF RACE

The “**Waikiki Offshore Series**” is a four race series sailed off the island of Oahu. The regatta consists of four (4) W/L of 4 to 12 nm (total for each race). Entries will be scored individually. The **Organizing Authority** for this event is the Waikiki Yacht Club.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Series will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the 2009 – 2012 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the ISAF SPECIAL REGULATIONS Governing Offshore and Ocean Equipment and Preparation, including US Sailing Prescriptions and any applicable class or rating division rules, except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. “Waikiki Offshore Series” will be conducted under ISAF Special Regulations “Category 5 Monohulls” except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. CLASSES TO RACE

- 2.1. The Regatta is open to all AmeriCap (ORR), offshore one-design and PHRF classes with 3 or more entries per division.
 - 2.1.1. Identification of grouping by division shall be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Owners of eligible offshore yachts are invited to apply for entry upon receipt of this Notice of Race by filling out the official entry forms available on the web site at www.waikikioffshores.com or from Waikiki Yacht Club office and the Entry Chair.
- 3.2. All entries shall be submitted to the Waikiki Yacht Club by July 21, 2010.

4. FEES

Entry fee for the series is \$45.00 for the PHRF. \$10.00 additional for ORR.

6 INSURANCE

6.1 All entries are required to provide evidence of Public Liability and Third Party Property Insurance coverage for the sum of US \$300,000 or more.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at Waikiki Yacht Club on Wednesday, July 21, 2010 at the Skippers Meeting.

8 SCORING

8.1 Series Scoring. The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. Each race will count as one score. The yacht with the lowest score, after any penalties may be applied, is the winner in each class.

8.2 AmeriCap/ORR Division. The AmeriCap/ORR Classes will be handicapped in accordance with the AmeriCap/ORR handicapping procedures. Course configuration will be the sole responsibility of the Race Committee. Decisions on course configuration shall not be a subject for redress.

8.3 PHRF Division. PHRF classes will be handicapped using the time-on-time method of handicapping as approved by HYRA.

8.4 For all classes - There will be no race throw out in this Series, modifying Appendix A - A2 Series Scores.

9 ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

9.1 In accordance with RRS 44.1, Two-Turn penalty, the Scoring Penalty for Infringement of a Rule of Part 2 shall apply.

10 Protests

10.1 Protest Time Limit is 1 hour after the race committee boat docks. Boats intended to protest will notify the race committee on the water at their finish modifying rule 61.1.

10.2 Protest art to be turned into the PRO or the WYC office by the Time Limit. Protest will be heard in the order received.

11 COMMUNICATIONS

11.1 All yachts shall be equipped with Marine VHF with Channels 16, 70, 71 and 72.

12 PRIZES

12.1 Individual prizes will be awarded to the first three yachts in each class for the entire Series.
